- Tulane Chinese Students & Scholars Association: Late Budget
 - Total is \$5,400
 - Holding two festivals in 2016
 - Mid-Autumn Festival and Spring Festival
 - More than 300 participants
 - Six years
 - Asking for \$5,050 for food
 - Both festivals are open to the public
 - Largest free food event on campus
 - No advisor – they must get advisor approval before we vote
 - 550 people in organization
 - Spent \$3080 (total budget)
 - Not decreasing because they spent it all but not increasing because late
 - Vote to table 15-0-0
 - Funded security in full plus 50
 - Funded decorations in full plus 20
 - Funded food 2730
- American Institute of Architecture Students: Late Budget
 - Requesting \$850 plus \$275
 - Total of \$1125
 - Primary is \$275 for national fees
 - Secondary is honoraria at \$250
 - Tertiary is publicity at \$50
 - Late Budget because of faculty advisor problem
 - Budget last year was \$575
 - Funded full dues
 - Funded full honoraria
 - Funded 50 in operating
 - Funded \$575 17-0-0
- Tulane Chinese Student Association: Late Budget
 - Requesting \$2050
 - Purpose is to acclimate Chinese students to America, introduce culture, etc
 - Late Budget because didn't realize you had to submit an electronic budget
 - Primary is International Food and Music Festival
 - Roughly 35 people in organization (including alumni)
 - Last year's budget was \$1600
 - They thought they had over 4K last year, but only given 1600 or 800
 - Only spent \$694 last year
 - If they had 800, we vote to fund 650 15-0-0
 - If they had 1600, we vote to fund 1200 14-1-0
- Chi Alpha trip to Fall Breakaway for all Chi Alphas: Travel Request

- 20 students asking for \$70 per person for \$1400
- Last year 15 students went, 20 before that
- This is a repeat trip
- They are paying out of pocket for transportation
- October 2 - 4 2015
- Freshmen – Seniors
- Voted to fund \$700 14-1-0

- Spoon: New Budget
 - Online media publication at over 85 schools
 - Requesting \$2000
 - They'll be having monthly events
 - Gets no money from headquarters
 - Votes to fund \$300 15-0-0
