  - \$4962

  - Largest engineering conference in whole world
  - Largest networking engineering for women
  - Largest undergraduate engineering career fair
  - SSE got a booth at fair
    - Advisor and 1 grad school are going
  - Goes on Regional Conference in Spring at U of Arkansas
    - Pres and treasurer
    - Driving
  - Has \$500 in leftover funds
  - Sending out letters to companies to help pay
  - Last year Newcomb funded Registration

    - Trying to grow team from 12 to 16
      - 4 freshmen, 6 sophomores, 3 juniors 3 seniors
