- School of Liberal Arts Government: Late Budget
 - Asking for \$3400
 - Late because last year's president did not submit a budget
 - Had \$0 last year but \$2000 the previous year and spent \$0
 - All events are open to the public, not just Lib Arts Students
 - Most important line item is the events expenses
 - Speakers, panels, food
 - Wants to cut the printing line item
 - Wants to do a career panel during Career Week with lib arts alums
 - Wants to bring in Naomi Cline (author)
 - Voted for \$1600 17-0-0
 - 100 for linked in
 - 1000 for speakers
 - 500 for food

- Juggling: Late Budget
 - Asking for \$2300
 - Need operating supplies to take care of Wall Garden and bike repair
 - Late because last year's president did not submit a budget
 - Last year got \$2000 and \$621
 - Fire juggling not a priority
 - Juggle twice a week each week
 - 20 members
 - Voted on 1100 14-3-0
 - 100 in gardening
 - 1000 in equipment

- J Street U Tulane: Late Budget
 - Asking for \$450
 - Wants to start a dialogue on campus for a two-state peaceful solution (Palestine and Israel)
 - Speakers Expenses more important than food
 - Funded \$250 in food unanimous vote

- GSAC: Late Budget
 - Asking for \$770
 - Not sure why they are late
 - Most important line item would be Mosaic Lounge material
 - Going to co-program with TUCP
 - Haven't had a budget for several years
 - Voted to fund \$350 unanimously

- Humans V Zombies: Late Budget
 - Once a semester event
 - Week-long struggle for survival
 - Cut \$600 because we don't fund uniforms
 - Cut \$900 from paintball because we fund travel separately
 - Cut \$160 from food for closed events
 - Equipment lost/stolen so they keep it at houses
 - Last year got \$725 and all was minor equipment
 - Late due to internal problems
 - Highest priority is props/repair
 - Funded \$500 unanimously
 - \$400 in equipment
 - \$100 in repairs

- Quiz Bowl to UL Lafayette on Oct 17: Travel Request
 - 10 people
 - \$270
 - 100 in transport
 - 170 in registration
 - Charge registration per team, not per person
 - Already went on this trip
 - Paid 60 in registration
 - Paid 20 in gas
 - We don't fund retroactively but they submitted before they went (Fall Break)
 - Submitted on Wednesday, 7th
 - Funded \$60 in registration 17-0-0

- Quiz Bowl Trip to Rice on Nov 6-8: Travel Request
 - 10 people
 - Predominantly freshmen, no sophomores, two seniors,
 - \$855
 - 300 transport (renting cars)
 - 205 registration
 - 350 lodging
 - 85.50 per person
 - Planning on being the last trip of the semester
 - 120 a team plus 35 in discount (two teams)
 - They paid their own registration for a previous trip (no other dues)
 - Funded \$445 17-0-0
 - 150 in transportation
 - 175 in lodging
 - 120 in registration

- Tulane Effective Altruism: New Budget

- Most important = events and promotion
- Trying to raise awareness
- Don't fund banners
- Priorities is office supplies
- Funded \$270 unanimously
 - \$150 in honoraria
 - \$120 in office supplies
