- Alpha Rho Chi March 17-20 to Charlotte NC: Late Budget
  - 4 people
  - Architectural Fraternity
  - 900, all in registration (early rate) (already paid)
  - National conference for Alpha Rho Chi
  - One member is author for a motion at the convention
  - One mandatory (seated delegate), three younger kids to get feet in door
  - Workshops, networking events, etc
  - They're paying their own flight (300-400 per), splitting hotel rooms with other chapters
  - Voted to fund 900 in full 14-0-0
  
- Quiz Bowl March 4-6 to Tuscaloosa: Late Budget
  - 9 people
  - 590
    - 100 transport
    - 250 lodging
    - 240 registration
  - This conference is open to non-college
  - Could be 200 in registration. Two teams (100 per)
  - Only debate they can go to this semester
  - Already given over 1000 in travel
  - Haven't spent anything in their 2 account
  - If we don't fund in full, they will dip into 9 account. They also pay nothing for this trip
  - Not funding registration because it's not a concrete number
  - Funding 125 in lodging 13-2-0
  
- TIPAC March 19-22 to DC: Late Budget
  - 18 people
  - 3120
    - 1850 transport
    - 1270 lodging
    - 0 registration
  - 20,000 people for this policy conference
  - The 18 people is arbitrary – not forced to go
    - Mostly freshmen
  - Conference has the most amount of congressmen outside of Capitol
  - Netanyahu, Obama have all attended
  - Sent two people last year
  - 6 bodies for lodging

- 6 bodies for transport
  - Their flights home are going everywhere (NY, etc) for Spring Break
  - They will pay out of pocket whatever we don't pay
  - Not funding transport because SB gets messy, also they should pay
  - Funding one hotel room (they sent two last year, we can pay for one hotel room)
  - 635 in lodging 14-1-0
- Debate March 17-23 to LBC California: Late Budget
    - 10 people
      - 8 debaters and 2 judges (required to bring)
    - 4799
      - 2116 airfare, 533 rental car, 100 gas in transport (2749 total)
      - 1650 lodging
      - 400 registration (4 teams)
    - Nationals Tournament (1<sup>st</sup> time going)
    - Airfare is only one way, Newcomb Tulane is funding the other way
    - Must stay in conference hotel
    - Priority is hotel/lodging
    - This is their priority trip this semester
    - Already paid 70 out of pocket per person to register
    - Pulled 295 out of 9 account for registration
    - Already told debaters they may have to pay for airfare back
    - Planning a fundraiser next Wednesday 2/17 selling donuts
    - Flights back may be flights home
    - Funding 1650 in lodging 15-0-0
- Debate March 10-12 to Lafayette LA: Late Budget
    - 14 people
      - 10 freshmen debaters, 2 judges, 2 varsity members
    - 1312
      - 550 transport
      - 582 lodging
      - 180 registration
    - Not their priority trip this semester
    - Funding 180 in registration 15-0-0
- TOGA March 3-6 to San Francisco: Late Budget
    - 12 people
    - 11272 total (9427) after 150 per person
      - 6652 transport
      - 3480 lodging
      - 1140 registration
    - 5<sup>th</sup> year going to this conference

- Their best conference
- Short of funding – Dean MacLaren is not funding as much as they normally do (lost 5K)
- Brand new person on this team, rare for this conference
- Staying at conference hotel, helps improve how they do
- One other trip, but they most likely won't request for the other since this is so high. Normally four trips a year, this year three
- People are already paying \$150 per person (number requested takes that into account)
- Cannot attend if they fund in part
- Can't cut delegates, already in correspondence with conference
- Went on four conferences last year
- Given 5780 thus far
- Funding 1140 in registration 10-0-0
