

### Mock Trial

### Reserve Request

Outdoor Water Fountain to be located outside McWilliams Hall: \$9615

- \$9534 for installation of fountain
- \$81 for inclusion of plaque: For the Health and Safety of Tulane, USG Senate (etc)

Request Details:

- Construction quoted and ready to go, would probably go through quickly with funding
- Once in place, facilities is responsible for upkeep
- McWilliams determined to be the best place based on data collection

Debate Details:

- Agreed to be in a good location for students; in the best interest of student safety

### Juggling Club

Travel Request: Total requested \$850

- \$100 Transportation
- \$500 Lodging
- \$250 Registration

Travel Details: Atlanta Juggle Fest, February 3-5, 2017 in Atlanta

10 Students to attend: about 4 freshmen and 4 seniors, not all confirmed

Conference Details:

- Usually go to Texas but that trip is during Mardi Gras this year
- Students will fund whatever is not funded: currently anticipating \$20 per student (factored into request)
- Hopefully a chance to get members more interested/involved in the club

### Motor Pool

Late Budget: Total Request \$25000

- Line items for gas, MVRs, etc: generally accepted to be all-or-nothing unless some gas is cut (of \$5000)

Last Year's Budget: Has been offline for more than a year. Looking to bring back fleet (has been in use but only for club sports)

Why Late: Has been in the works all year, finally all set to go

Organization Details:

- A fleet of vans for use by student organizations traveling somewhat locally
- Fuel plus \$5 to be paid by USG for any trip under 100 miles
- Over 100 miles, organizations do not pay fuel but pay \$5 for every 0-12 hours over 100 miles from their 9 account

Budget Details:

- Would be funding the trial program for this semester: looking to overshoot with \$25000, as it will roll back into the reserve anyway, to allow for better future forecasting

Debate Details:

- Obviously something needed in the community
- The late budget pool was expanded specifically for this reason
- The budget has already been cut down in previous talks

### TIPAC (Tulane Israeli Public Affairs Committee)

Travel Request: Total requested \$8489 (of total cost \$12164)

- \$3800 Transportation
- \$2970 Lodging
- \$5394 Registration

Travel Details: AIPAC Policy Conference, March 25-28, 2017 in Washington, DC

21 Students to attend: 9 freshmen, 20 fully confirmed, 19 regular TIPAC attendees

Conference Details:

- National Policy Conference on Israeli affairs: one of the largest DC conferences
- Has hosted Presidential candidates, White House representatives, policy experts
- Open for everyone who wants to go: 3500 students attend total, including peer institutions
- Seat cost is \$600, but received subsidies by student
- Hotel rates are up, but chose a cheaper option
- Plane tickets for one way since it occurs at the start of break
- Last year only given \$635, but more subsidies were available to more students
- Expecting each student to fundraise \$175

Debate Details:

- Possibly necessary to cut transportation: spring break issue
- Consider cut of two less-involved members
- \$4689 funds 21 for all but Transportation, or \$223/person (6 votes)
- \$3511 funds 19 for all but Transportation, or \$184/person (7 votes)

**Propose \$3511, \$2640 Lodging and \$871 Registration, 7-6-2**

Travel Request: Total requested \$2000

- 0 Transportation
- 0 Lodging
- \$1000-\$2000 Registration

Travel Details: AMA International Collegiate Conference, March 16-18 in New Orleans

Unsure how many students will attend; 2 confirmed

Conference Details:

- Registration is \$200 per person for members
- Looking to take 5-10 people, can confirm 6 would be interested, including 1 freshman
- Like Career Wave for marketing students, with competitions to be won
- Have not confirmed attendance yet due to lack of funding/high registration, but confident in interest; 300% member increase since last year.

Debate Details:

- Fund 6 for-sure-would-commit members to attend
