- Why/how did they choose this competition?
 - There is a circuit of competitions that happen across the US, with regional ones like this one being the easiest, then escalating to nationals
 - They applied to TX, GA, NC because they are the most reasonable distance
 - This is a newer competition, so they are giving an opportunity to smaller dance teams an opportunity to compete

Presentation Details:

- Flights are 288 per person
- Rooms are 89 per night, 890 total
 - They budgeted for 5 rooms for 2 nights each
- Registration is 40 per person
 - 560 total
- They are required to be there on Friday evening, so flights are better and more efficient so that they do not miss class
- Notes from Maggie
 - We fund 4 people to a room
 - We no longer fund grad students for travel because of lack of GAPSA funding
- How did you decide who is going?
 - There is a required minimum of people per team for the competition
 - 12 people must be on stage at all times
 - The required amount of dancing is 10 minutes, so this makes the physical toll easier
- Is anyone paying for themselves or contributing?
 - They have already paid registration out-of-pocket, but they are hoping to get reimbursed
 - They don't want to pay for anything because they don't want to be a financial burden for their members
 - This is a cultural experience, so there is personal value
